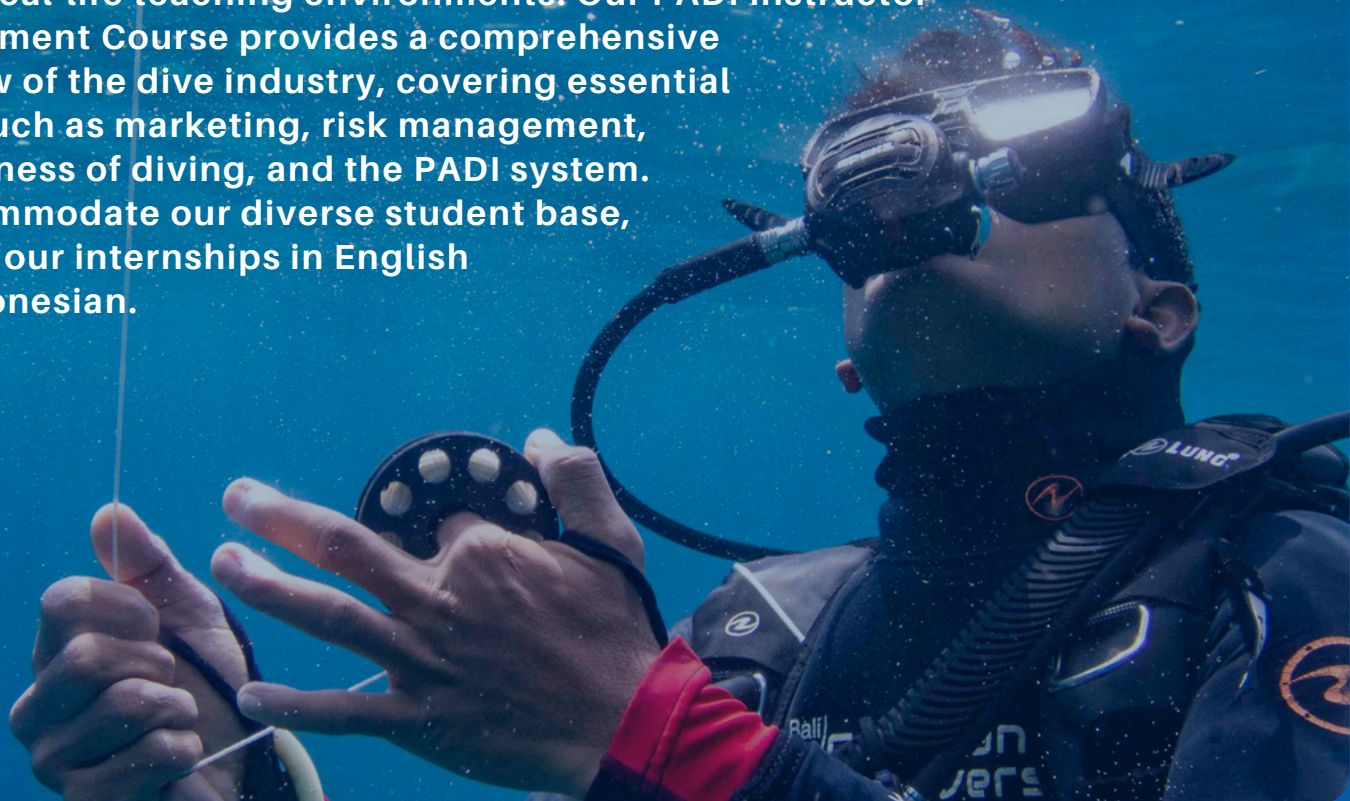

PRE-REQUISITES

- Be a PADI Divemaster or hold an equivalent leadership-level certification from another diver training organization.
- Be at least 18 years old.
- Have completed and logged a minimum of 60 dives, as recorded in your logbook, including night, deep, and navigation dives.
- Have been a certified diver for at least 6 months.
- Provide medical clearance for diving fitness, signed by a physician within the last 12 months.
- Hold a current Emergency First Response Primary and Secondary Care course certification (or equivalent), completed within the past 24 months.

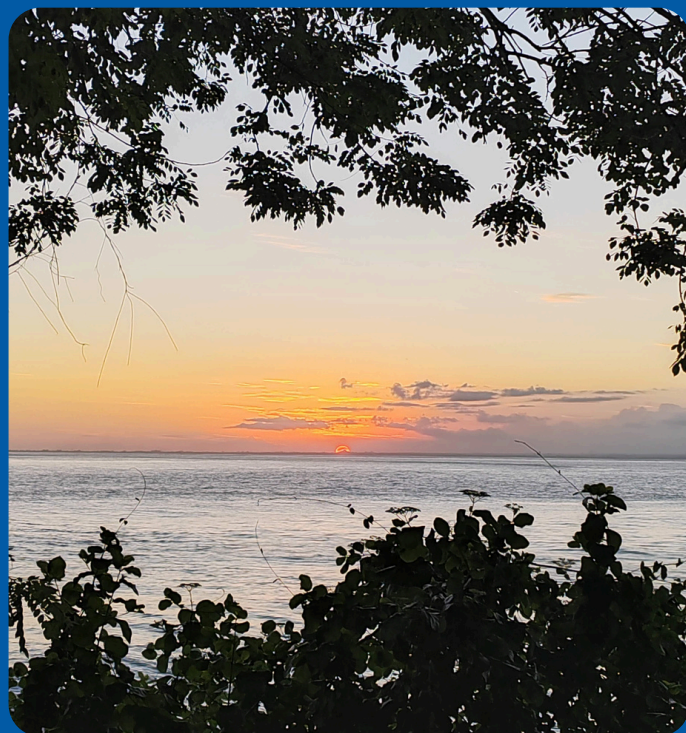
